TO ALL BODIES OF ELDERS

Dear Brothers:

You will soon be receiving a small supply of the insert titles "Are You Ready to Face a Faith-Challenging Medical Situation?" This insert appeared in the March 1991 *Our Kingdom Ministry*.

How are these items to be used? The secretary should keep them on hand so that they can be given to all newly baptised individuals. The insert and a copy of the *Medical Directive/Release* card can be made available right after baptism. (If these newly baptised ones have any unbaptised children, you may also wish to acquaint them with the Identity Card many parents use for their children.) Take a moment or two to explain the use and value of these items to these new brothers and sisters.

To prepare baptismal candidates for this in the future, it is recommended that during the time when the elders review the questions from *Organized to Accomplish Our Ministry* prior to baptism, the subject of blood on pages 190 and 191 be considered carefully. At that time the insert and the card should also be mentioned, and the candidate should be told that he will receive a copy when he is baptised.

Your circuit overseer will have some additional points for you about this during a future visit to the congregation.

Additional copies of the insert and of the *Medical Directive/Release* card may be ordered on the regular Literature Order form while stocks last.

We pray Jehovah's blessing on this arrangement.
