Re: *Watchtower Library—2010*

Dear Brothers:

The first edition of the research tool *Watchtower Library* was released in 1993, in English. Since then, the number of languages has grown. The 2010 edition will be produced in 39 languages. Thus, brothers and sisters around the globe will be able to benefit from it.

One particular feature of *Watchtower Library* has proved useful to Witnesses who speak more than one of those languages. That is the provision to synchronize between language editions that are installed and open on a computer. For example, a Witness serving with a foreign-language congregation or group may do research in one language then use the synchronize feature to find the equivalent text in another language. (The beginning date of publications is not the same in all editions.) This synchronization feature has been quite valuable to brothers and sisters learning a new language so as to spread the good news. Following is a list of the 39 languages in which *Watchtower Library—2010* will be produced:
